

1. Storage & Handling

- Store dry ice in an **insulated container**, NOT sealed airtight
 - **Never store in glass or tightly closed containers.**
 - Keep dry ice **away from children's reach** before and after the show.
 - Use **thick gloves or tongs** when handling.

2. Ventilation

- Use **only in well-ventilated areas**
-

3. During the Show

- Dry ice is safe to use for **science experiments, bubbling cauldrons, fog effects**, etc., **only under adult supervision.**
 - **Do not allow children to touch** the dry ice directly without gloves.
 - Use **large plastic or metal containers** for fog effects – ensure they are **stable** and away from the edge of tables.

4. Prohibited Uses

- No dry ice in **balloons, sealed jars, or plastic bottles**
 - Don't use dry ice for any activities that involve **children** without supervision.
 - Do not dispose of dry ice in **sinks, toilets, or trash bins.**

5. Disposal

- Let leftover dry ice **sublimate in an open, well-ventilated space**, away from kids and pets.
 - Never seal leftover dry ice in a container to "save it" – it's **not reusable** in most cases.
